Abstracts will be accepted from November 01, 2014 through February 01, 2015.

The Association for Research into Crimes against Art and the city of Amelia will be hosting its seventh-annual interdisciplinary conference June 26-28, 2015. This weekend conference aims to facilitate a critical appraisal of the protection of art and cultural heritage by bringing together academics, police, members of the art world, as well as the students in ARCA's postgraduate certificate program in Art Crime and Cultural Heritage Protection.

The conference will be held in the picturesque town of Amelia, Italy in the heart of Umbria. During this event ARCA will present its annual awards—chosen by ARCA's Trustees and past award winners—to honor outstanding scholars and professionals dedicated to the protection and recovery of cultural heritage.
