Proof by affidavit having been made this day before me by Special Agent John Paul Labbat Shield # 2820, of the Department of Homeland Security-Homeland Security Investigations (DHS-HSI), that there is reasonable cause to believe that certain property, to wit:

- a. **A Sardinian Marble Female Idol of the Ozieri Culture** (the “**Sardinian Idol**”), circa 2500-2000 B.C.E, approximately 13.75 inches long, which was listed as Lot 85 in the December 11, 2014, Antiquities auction held by Christie’s where it was valued at \$800,000-\$1,200,000. (Exhibit A); and
- b. **A Roman frescoed panel of a Mythological Scene** (the “**Ercolano Fresco**”), circa first century C.E., which depicts the following scene: “to the left is an infant Hercules strangling a snake sent to him in his cradle by Hera because he was the offspring of Hera’s husband’s adulterous union with Alcmena; Jove is depicted in the center of the panel in the form of an eagle on a globe; on the right is Amphitryon, Alcmena’s husband, seated on a low stool and observing,” and which is believed to have been purchased in approximately 1996 for approximately \$600,000 (Exhibit B);

May be found in the apartment of MICHAEL STEINHARDT at 1158 Fifth Avenue, Apartment 16A, New York, New York (“the target premises”); and that the above described property constitutes evidence, and tends to demonstrate that the crime of Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the First Degree was committed;

YOU ARE THEREFORE COMMANDED, between 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m., to enter and to search the target premises, for the above-described property, and if you find such property or any part thereof to bring it before the Court without unnecessary delay.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the affidavit is sealed, except that the affidavit may be disclosed by an Assistant District Attorney in the New York County District Attorney’s Office in the course of the lawful discharge of his or her duties pursuant to a criminal investigation and/ or prosecution, or upon written order of the Court.

This warrant must be executed within 10 days of the date of issuance.
